The year 2019-20 was filled with both happiness and challenges. As we have initiated new programs supporting slum dwellers and underprivileged children. We have supported the education of many underprivileged children through our Education Support program helping them to continue their education. Also, conducted health camps for the slum dwellers.

To provide free digital education and skill-based education such as Art & Craft, theatre, dance and sports to underprivileged children studying in government schools, we have started the Community Program which has benefitted 1000+ underprivileged children within a year. Our school Utkarsha Learning Center enrolled 80+ children in the academic year.

North Karnataka has seen one of the worst floods in its history. In this critical situation, Mahesh Foundation extended support to needy people in rural areas. We have organized free healthcare camps in the flood-affected areas and distributed school kits and medicines kits to the children in collaboration with many corporate.

Mahesh Foundation has been breaking barriers and misconceptions on the abilities of the medically challenged and underprivileged children but without the support from our followers, who always have been by our side, we would not have been able to meet our purpose. We have complete belief in our people and the organization is always at the forefront leading our beneficiaries and their pursuits towards fruition.

About Mahesh Foundation

Our Vision

To realize a world without the Stigma & Discrimination attached to HIV/AIDS & empowering Children afflicted with this disease.

Our Mission

To enable medically challenged and underprivileged children to live an independent and dignified life.

Mahesh Foundation has been working for the welfare of HIV-positive and underprivileged children for the past 12 years. The Foundation is providing shelter, nutrition, healthcare, and education to HIV-positive and underprivileged children. Our core focus over the last decade has been to provide education to these children so that they live dignified lives.

In the past 12 years, the Foundation's Care Home has directly benefited over 600 girls and 1000 boys. Our Community Support program has impacted the lives of 20000 HIV-infected socially disadvantaged families. Also, raised awareness among school and college students. The Foundation commenced a school, "Utkarsha" for HIV-positive special children as well as underprivileged children in 2018 and benefited around 1000 HIV-positive and underprivileged children.

In more than a decade of the fruitful journey, it was realized that imparting skills is most important for these children to become self-sustained. So, Mahesh Foundation started providing skill-based education such as computers, art & craft, theater, dance and more to them as well as the government school children who are unfortunate enough to get it in their schools.

We have worked on the floor hit Gokak and other rural areas and supported the needy people by providing them the necessary help like healthcare, medicines and school kits to the children.
