Mahesh Foundation at Glance

Mahesh Foundation came into existence in the year 2008. It is a safe shelter home Ashakiran for HIV-infected children between the age group of 6-18 years. Mahesh Foundation was started when the founder Mahesh Jadhav met a 4-year-old boy in a government hospital in Belagavi. The care home has now sheltered 45 children and reached 2000+ beneficiaries over the years. Ashakiran functions under the Juvenile Justice Act (JJ Act) & the beneficiaries are sanctioned by the Child Welfare Committee.

Apart from the care home, Mahesh Foundation runs a school Utkarsha Learning Center for HIV-infected, slum & underprivileged children providing skill-based education. The Aadhar Vidya Program supports the education of needy children. To date, supported over 20000 children. Mahesh Foundation extends healthcare services to 37000+ Individuals living with HIV in rural areas. Many children who were admitted to the care home were counting the days but now they are living a healthy, independent and dignified life. Since its inception, Mahesh Foundation has been maintaining zero mortality.

Mahesh Foundation also supports the livelihood of the underprivileged women who lost their sole breadwinner or are unfortunate to get their backing from them. The program was started in 2014 and since then supported 1500+ needy women.

Mahesh Foundation is registered under the Karnataka Societies Registration Act and is eligible for legal status. In addition, Mahesh Foundation is eligible for the tax benefits under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act. It is also registered under the FCRA (Foreign Contribution Regulation Act) to receive

donations from foreign sources implying the great financial stability of the organization.

The founder Mahesh Jadhav was honored with the National Award for Child Welfare by the Government of India. The organization has received ISO 9001:2015 from the Indian Standards Organization. The organization is recognized as the FIT institution by the Government of Karnataka in 2014.

Our Prime Concern:

The children whom we are supporting, usually come from the poorest of the poor sections of the society living in the slums and rural. These underprivileged children have no access to basic needs such as running water, toilets and electricity. And HIV-infected children mainly come from rural areas and are orphans as well as abandoned by their relatives. They face stigma and discrimination in society for their HIV status.

The main profession of the parents is rag-picking, petty sales and begging. These underprivileged children are discriminated and are not accepted in mainstream schools. Children who should be in school at this tender age are left on the streets to play, while their parents are off to work.

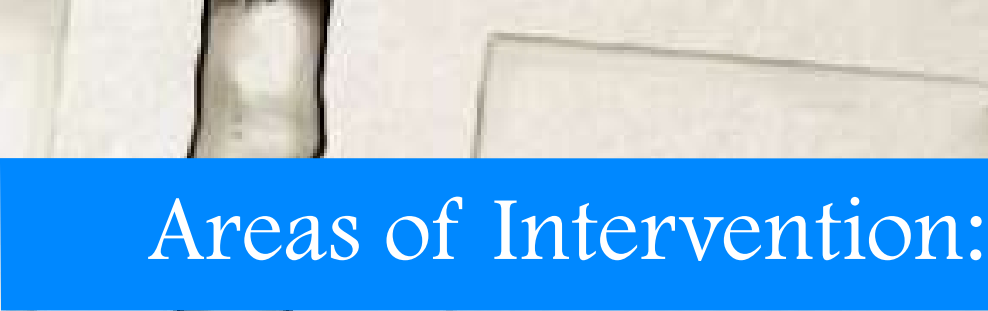

Areas of Intervention:

Education

Helping HIV-positive, slum and underprivileged children to continue education.

Aadhar Vidya Program:

This program was started in the year of 2012. It operates in providing Education support for HIV-affected, slum & poor children free of cost, it is benefiting more than 1800 children till day.

Utkarsha Learning Center:

This program was started in the year of 2016. This program is providing free school and education for HIV-affected & slum children. Till the day it has reached more than 1300 students by providing this facility.

Healthcare

Provided shelter to HIV-infected children and also extended healthcare service to People Living with HIV in rural areas.

Women Empowerment

Providing training on Tailoring, Art & Craft skill based training and livelihood opportunities to underprivileged women. Trained beneficiaries would get the opportunity of income generated to sustain their family's livelihood.

Community Support

Adopting schools and helping them with infrastructure development and providing school kits to needy children. We reached around 500 + children till day, for 2030 we have an aim of reaching 10000+ students.



Responding to the Global Pandemic

Responding to the COVID-19 crisis, worked day and night to save the lives of struggling patients by providing oxygen cylinders to 600 needy patients. Also, provided oxygen concentrators to 200 patients. During the COVID-19 crisis, the Government of Karnataka announced the lockdown. As the rural people who were admitted to COVID care centers were struggling for access to food, the foundation distributed food to over 5000 needy patients and the attenders accompanied the patients.

The Covid-19 ravages the livelihood of slum dwellers. They used to work in various sections to earn their daily bread. So, distributed food packets to the slum dwellers in and around Belagavi city. Distributed masks to over 4 lakh needy people. Especially HIV+ve people living in rural areas. Reached ART centers in the hospitals and also reached the doorstep of the needy to provide masks. Along with masks, distributed ART medicines to thousands of People Living with HIV.

In the tough times of the COVID-19 pandemic, Mahesh Foundation provided ration kits to 1500 needy families who lost their livelihood in lockdown.

Our Mission -

Designing high-quality student centric programs that focus on developing well-rounded individuals with love for learning.

Our Vision -

To provide a conducive learning environment and a holistic school for medically challenged and underprivileged children.

School Bag Distribution:

Under our School Support Program, we have been supporting underprivileged children studying in Government Schools. As a part of this initiative, we have adopted education, supporting the education of hundreds of children this year.

Computer Classes Restarted:

We provide skill-based education to underprivileged children studying in nearby government schools. Started a new batch of computer classes. Every day 450+ children are benefiting from our Skill-based education program.



Utkarsha Learning Center

Utkarsha Learning Center, a school of Mahesh Foundation for HIV-positive and underprivileged children. The school prefers skills along with formal education. At Utkarsha, we are geared up to use the best instructional practices to support the learners. Utkarsha has enrolled more than 100 HIV infected and less privileged slum children with an equal number of boys and girls. Our goal is to reach 500 children by 2024 with at least 50% of girls and have a well-built school with all the infrastructure that children needed. Currently, the school ensures basic education to these children up to the 8th standard.



My family was unable to afford the rising education cost, so I was supposed to drop out of my education due to poverty. With the help of Mahesh Foundation, I am getting free education along with nutritional food. I am happy to learn here.

WE BELIEVE THAT EVERY CHILD NEEDS THE SECURITY OF A HOME

As you read this, thousands of HIV-positive children have lost their parents and been abandoned by their relatives. Many survive with substandard care, unloved and at health risk. Apart from this, they would also face stigma and discrimination for their HIV/AIDS status. But we are also in an attempt at a profound paradigm shift. Efforts are being made to bring change in the lives of HIV-positive children. There may not be a cure for AIDS yet, but we still have the power to help rewrite the future of these children.

Mahesh Foundation has attempted to bridge this gap by initiating a program that is committed to providing treatment, nutrition, shelter, education and psychological support to the children infected and affected by HIV/AIDS. At our care home, we aim to improve the overall health, mental development and well-being of our children. We provide comprehensive care to the children enrolled in our care home.

Children Health Monitoring

As a precaution against the COVID-19, we at Mahesh Foundation regularly monitor the health conditions of the children. For every 15 days, Dr. Amey Usulkar conducts health check-ups of the children and prepares their health report.

COVID-19 Awareness Program in Gokak

Organized a COVID-19 awareness program for the People Living with HIV at our Care and Support Center in Gokak. Also, distributed masks and sanitizers as well as ration kits. 200+ families benefited.

Home Visit

Our team's home visit, to follow up with the children who were residing at our care home and left to live independently. Distributed essentials for their health and education such as tabs, and school kits.



Community Engagment

SKDRDP visit:

SKDRDP team visited Mahesh Foundation on their exploring visit. The founder Mahesh Jadhav addressed the SKDRDP team in a session and conveyed the responsibilities of parents while raising their children and making them responsible citizens in the future.

KLE College Students at Mahesh Foundation:

Teachers and students team of K.L.E. Society B.V.Bellad Law College, Belagavi made an exploring visit to Mahesh Foundation. Mahesh Jadhav interacted with them in a session and introduced our various initiatives that are benefitting thousands of underprivileged children and women. The Electric Machine Provided:

A 75-year-old elderly man who lives a poor life is saving the traditional pottery culture and promoting it. Also, he is dependent on this pottery to earn his daily bread. He had to stand for a long time to work but he doesn't have enough energy to stand up and work. Mahesh Foundation provided an Electric-Powered pots-making machine for him.

House renovation:

A woman lost her husband 3 months ago due to health issues caused by excessive consumption of alcohol. The woman was living in a 25-year-old house with her two kids. The house was leaking from the haunting rain and was dangerous for living. Renovated their house and also took education responsibilities for her two children.

Interaction with students:

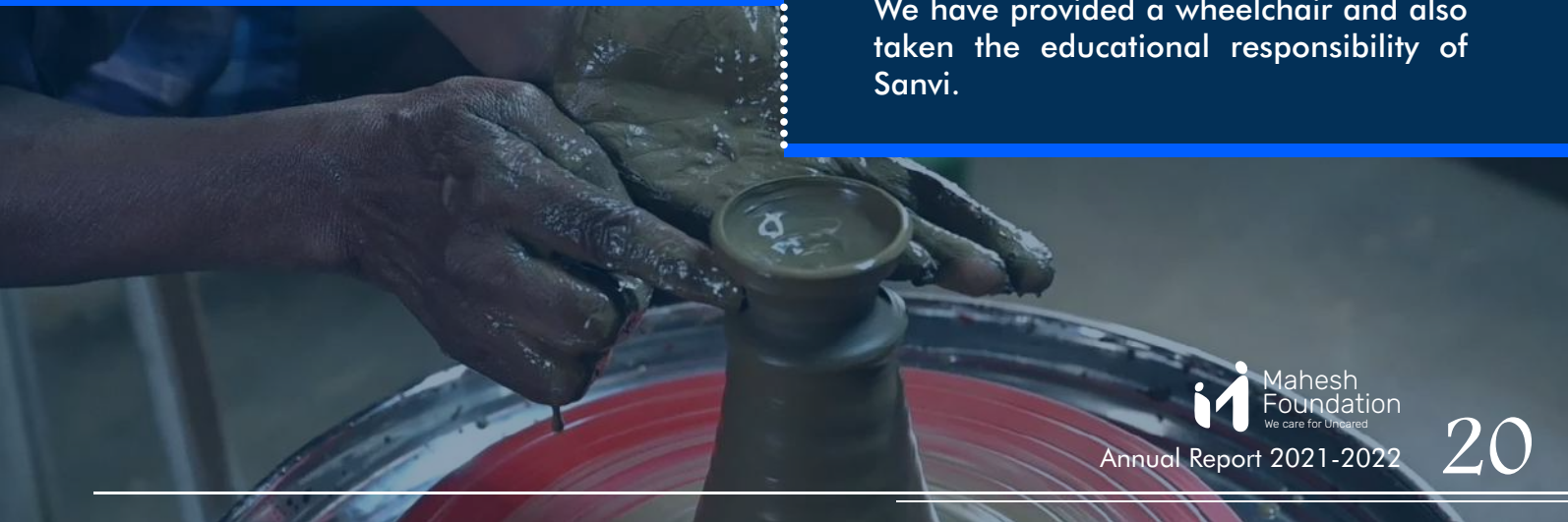
Interacted with Hotel Management Students and conveyed the importance of their role in the development of society.

Life Skills Education is a form of education that focuses on cultivating the personal life skills of children. Under the LSE, we also teach the children self-awareness and goal setting. Skills develop self-reflection, critical thinking, problem-solving skills and interpersonal skills.

Guiding the children in making a passionate career:

Mr. Girish Naganur conducted a session on Career counseling for the children studying the 12th standard. He presented the career options available to the children after completing the 12th standard.

Yoga to lead a peaceful life

Yoga is flame when you light it up, the glow never fades away. The children practice yoga with the guidance of volunteers and its benefit in their day-to-day life. Along with medication, yoga is also important for children as it helps them to maintain good health.

Exploring the artist hidden inside the child:

Along with studies children learn curricular activities like painting, art & craft and more. These art & craft fun activities will provide them with a better experience and make them become creative. We provide skill-based education to children who lack essential educational facilities.

Nurturing artistic skills among children:

Bhagvad Gita: Teaching the way of life to the children

But her earnings were not sufficient to provide the much-needed nutrition and medication to Priyanka. So, her health condition was not good. Also, she went in shock because of her father's death. So, her mother enrolled Priyanka in Mahesh Foundation. She has unstable health as well as she was unable to concentrate on the things when she was admitted to our care home. But, with proper care and medication, Priyanka recovered. She studied well and pursued higher education. She learned communication, computer teaching and more skills that are helping her to become a teacher. Now, she is working as a teacher at Utkarsha Learning Center.

'Wall of Humanity' set up to help needy in city

GIVING a helping hand to the poor, Mahesh Foundation has launched 'Wall of Humanity' where ration kits are hung to a wall so that needy people can easily collect them without any procedures or permission at Kanbargi in Belagavi.

Speaking to The New Indian Express, Mahesh Jadhav, founder president of Mahesh Foundation, said that in this lockdown period, many organisations and groups are helping the needy. "Along with low-income people, middle class people are also affected by the lockdown as they lost their livelihood in this crisis. But they hesitate to ask for help for one or other reasons," he said.

To help such people, Jadhav said he set up the 'Wall of Hu-

manity' in Belagavi. "These kits include ration materials worth Rs 1,000," he added. Jadhav said, "In the past many days, this initiative has assisted many needy families. There are thousands of under-

privileged and slum dwellers residing in and around Kanbargi and they have lost their livelihood due to lockdown. We are helping them."

Jadhav said, "Each kit has 8 kg rice packet, 2 kg dal (two

types), 2 kg poha, 3 kg sugar, 1 kg tea powder, 3 bath and 3 washing soaps as well as tablets that help them in case of general cold and fever. In the past 10 days, we have provided kits to more than 600 families. Every day, we keep 50-60 kits on the wall. Along with this, Mahesh Foundation has taken 'Ration kit at doorstep' initiative," he said.

"Our volunteers are reaching out to people in Kalakumbh, Sambar, Rukmini Nagar, Sagar Nagar Slum and Marihal and we provided more than 800 kits at the doorstep of underprivileged families residing in these areas. We collect information about the needy from grama panchayat members and others, reach their home with ration kits and place it at their doorstep. We have a team of 15 volunteers," concluded Jadhav.

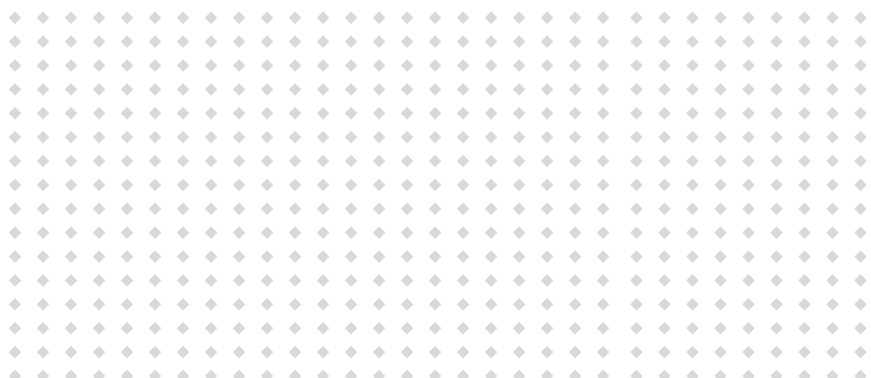
