Mahesh Foundation, a non-governmental organization working for the welfare of children and youth affected by HIV/AIDS in society by ensuring them education and encouraging them to fight against HIV/AIDS the deadly disease.



Mahesh Foundation runs"AADHAR"& "ASHAKIRAN" Orphanage, where more than 55HIV infected &affected orphans are sheltered.





Membership.	In order to strengthen the organization and broaden the base the Managing committee took efforts to enroll more and more members due to which the total members as on 31 st March 2014 are as follows Members –166.
Managing Committee Meeting.	The Managing committee meeting is conducted 1st Sunday of every month at Mahesh Foundation . So there were 13 meetings during the year.
New Admissions in AADHAR & Ashakiran orphanages.	During the year we are newly adopted 02 HIV infected & affected orphan children in AADHAR orphanage & Ashakiran Orphanage. Total Sheltered Children – 45

Activities:

Shelter HIV Infected and Affected orphan Children.



AADHAR orphanage works for orphans and vulnerable children. This orphanage shelter **45** children and caters to their varied requirements including Shelter, Medicine, Nutrition and Education. From the year 2013 these facilities are given to some more children by opening up a new orphanage "Asha Kiran" n today we count 45 children getting shelter.

Total Sheltered children- 45

Nutrition Support to Children Living with HIV.



Mahesh Foundation provides nutrition support for 350 Children Living with HIV/AIDS in Belgaum district that adds up to 20% of total CLHIV in whole Belgaum district. The instances say that two CLHIV children on an average are dead because of non availability of proper nutrition food, as it is non practical to shelter all 1700+ children. Mahesh Foundation is trying to at least supply nutrition food to CLHIV so that it helps to keep them alive.

Total Benefitted children - 435.



AADHAR HIV/AIDS Helpline



The Objective of the Helpline is not only to help and assist those infected with HIV/AIDS but also to create awareness about the disease. People are hesitant to reveal the truth due to the social stigma attached. As a result, patients do not receive proper counselling or timely medicine. The trauma caused by the knowledge of infection is often so severe as to drive youth and couples to suicide.

People having questions about HIV/AIDS are hesitant to ask because of social stigma and unfounded fears. The Telephonic/Online Helpline will guarantee complete anonymity while providing answers. This would serve to dispel misconceptions and wrong notions regarding the disease and instil confidence and hope in people who would otherwise languish in misery.

HIV is considered a "disease of the others" i.e. of people living in the margins of society with questionable lifestyles. This prevents people from seeking information and help. Lack of correct information can result in either indifference or panic, both of which are undesirable from a societal point of view.

Total Benefitted - 15600 people.

Free Hospital for HIV infected People.



Mahesh Foundation providesfree hospital services for HIV affected people. By having a hospital of 15 beds we provided this service for more than 1000 affected people and in next year we intend to reach more than 2000 people with this free hospital facility.

Total Benefitted - 3216 people.

AADHAR Village



AADHAR village program involves the identification of communities long ignored by authorities and society at large, example slums and shanties, and providing the residents there with healthcare, education and improving their living conditions by involving the residents as well as bringing in volunteers. These areas have long been associated with sub-standard living conditions negligence to basic sanitation and health needs. By this program we were successful to reach more than 350 families and 600 children.

Total Benefitted – 9620 people.

We provide food to the person from a family of a patient admitted in district hospital as we have seen, they from urban areas, they are poor and needy. This seva is provided to 25 patient's family throughout the year. We have an intention to give this facility to 50 patients.

Youth Awareness about Social Responsibility.



Mahesh Foundation has taken steps forward even in youth awareness, by allowing the youngsters to celebrate festivals with the children of our orphan age, we have done youth awareness in various colleges, telling them about social responsibilities to give same love and care which we get from our parents to such children by celebrating birthdays with them spending time with them giving them a feel of being a family, keeping the good network with collage students have given us very enthusiastic volunteers who comes to our programs n give their helping hands.

After one experience young generation has come to a conclusion that they want to give their support for needy people. More than 4500 + college students visited Mahesh Foundation during year.

We **Independence Day** celebrated this 66th INDEPENDNCE day in our orphanage giving the same INDEPENDENT and discrimination free life to the Children Effected by HIV. On 9th Sept we celebrated "Ganesh chaturthi" in Ashakiran "Ganesh Chaturthi" Orphanage. We have brought Ganesh idol for five days and these five days our orphanage was filled Joy and happiness. On 10th Sept we organized Health check up for slum **Health Check up Camp** dwellers which have lead for development of Aadhar community center for welfare of slum dwellers. **Joy Of Giving Week** On the day 2nd of Oct 2013. We successfully Inaugurated the "JOY OF GIVING WEEK". As we have Maintained our social consciousness the people who appreciated our work joined us together for the Inauguration of "JOY OF GIVING WEEK" and told people to give something back to the society n feel that JOY OF GIVING. The "BIGBAZAR" Belgaum took initiative and helped us to do this successfully. On 13th Oct we celebrated "Dasara" a festival which shows **Dasara Celebration** triumph of good over evil. We celebrated this festival with old age people of Shantatai Asharam. Dasara celebration brought joy on faces of both old age people and children. Celebration of "DIWALI" On 24th Oct we celebrated "DIWALI" a festival of lights in our orphanage. We celebrated this festival with same joy

Christmas Celebration	On 25 th December children enjoyed Christmas a lot as Santa was there for them with gifts. Our donor dressed in Santa Claus dress gifted children.
Kannerimath tour	One day trip to Kannerimath for Mahesh Foundation children was organized by Mr Nikhil Maduskar. This trip was of full enjoyment for the children. Through this trip children came to know about culture our ancestors were following, their lifestyle and have seen artistic way of presentation of history. They also played games.
ID & Makarsankrant	On occasion of Id, Makar Sankranti and our inmate's birthday, Mr Feroz Sait, MLA of North Belgaum visited Mahesh Foundation at Ashakiran orphanage.
